Due to slavery (and later segregation), black Americans were denied admission to traditionally white institutions. The Higher Education Act of 1965 defines HBCUs as an accredited higher education institution established prior to 1964, whose "principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans." Currently, the107 HBCUs (both public and private entities) serve more than 228,000 students throughout the country. WRITTEN REQUIREMENT	Full Two-Page Essay (Font: Arial 12pt., Double-spaced) Essay Question: Do HBCUs better prepare African American students for post graduate life? Explain in detail.
INTERVIEW	Applicant must be available for a phone interview in April 2025
COLLEGE ADMISSION	Selected Scholarship recipient must provide proof of enrollment into his/her upcoming HBCU (upon request)

A COMPLETE application packet must include the following:

- 1. Completed 2025 HBCU Scholarship Application (pages 2 & 3 only).
- 2. <u>Unofficial</u> High School Transcripts may be submitted during the application process. Scholarship awardees will be required to submit Official transcripts upon request.
- 3. TWO Letters of Recommendation (Accepted from applicant's teachers, counselors, principal or community members.
- 4. Essay (Two Pages: See details above in Section VI under Written Requirement)
